

Information on JRR-3 Safety Education

This safety education is required to be taken at least once a year when working as a radiation worker at the JRR-3 test reactor owned by the Nuclear Science Research Institute of the Japan Atomic Energy Agency.

1. Holding method

◎It will be conducted by participants participating in live streaming using the online meeting system (Zoom).

◎When taking the online course, please prepare the following environment.

- PC with built-in camera or PC with external camera connected
- Internet line
- Microphone

◎After taking the course, it is necessary to fill in the "Safety Education and Training Participant Questionnaire as a record of the course taken by the participant himself / herself and submit it by e-mail. If you do not submit the questionnaire, you will not be able to complete the course.

2. Date

◎The dates are as shown in the attached schedule.

◎The start time is as follows.

Japanese	13:30
English	15:30
	However, depending on the application status, it may be moved up to 13:30.

3. Precautions

◎The deadline for application is the Monday of the week before the desired date.

◎It is recommended to connect with a wired LAN with stable communication.

◎ For online courses, please access Zoom at least 10 minutes before the course. Please note that if the number of hours is less than the prescribed number of hours due to late access, you may not be able to complete the course.

◎When accessing Zoom, please use your name (display name) as your affiliation/full name.
Example: The University of Tokyo/Taro Todai

◎When accessing Zoom, please test the video, speakers, and microphone.

◎Please turn on the video during the course. Through video footage, the secretariat will check the status of attendance. If you disconnect, leave your seat, or turn off video and are unable to confirm your attendance, you may not be able to complete the course.

- ◎If the Secretariat is unable to confirm the status of attendance, we may check the status of attendance via Zoom chat etc.
- ◎If you are unable to take part of the course due to a malfunction of the Internet line, etc., you can take a supplementary course and complete it at the date and time specified by the Secretariat by making an offer by the end of the course.
- ◎Please submit the "Safety Education and Training Student Questionnaire" by e-mail by the day after the completion of the online course.
